Project CAMPUS aims to create a safer and expanded campus for St. Elizabeth School, addressing challenges like a safer bus route and accommodating growth. With the relatively recent acquisition of additional land behind the school, the project will provide more parking, classroom and outdoor recreational space, and work-based learning opportunities while beautifying Baltimore City's Pen Lucy neighborhood.

St. Elizabeth School's stellar reputation has allowed for a positive trajectory in student enrollment, and Project CAMPUS will allow us to properly accommodate this growth.
